Motivated Moms

EFAA's *Internships to Careers for Motivated Moms* program helps low-income mothers improve their long-term earning potential. For a mom supporting her family, this can mean going from a dead-end minimum wage job that can't pay the bills to one that pays \$14 an hour, with room for growth in the future.

Improving income even a little bit can mean putting food on the table, and paying the rent both in the same month. In other words, it can be the difference between a stable home or family homelessness.

13.9% of Boulder County residents are food insecure, meaning they do not have access to enough food to support a healthy life. 11,000 of the food insecure are children.



25% of all students in BVSD and SVVSD are eligible for free or reduced lunch at school.



EFAA has distributed **400,000** pounds of food since July, enough to feed 1,500 households for 5 weeks, giving them the breathing room they need to catch up on critical expenses for other basic needs.

\$60,000 Hynd Trust Grant for Vision Care

The Hynd Trust grant for vision care provides nearly 200 adults and children with access to vision testing and glasses. Glasses can open the world to someone who needs them. Imagine not having the vision care you need to see lessons in school, fill out a job application, or drive safely to work?
